The Sloatsburg Library is hosting September 11, 2001: The Day That Changed the World. This 9/11 Memorial and Museum curated exhibition reflects the core pillars of commemoration, education and inspiration, as we prepare to observe the 20th Anniversary of the 9/11 attacks. This educational exhibition recounts the events of September 11, 2001, through the personal stories of those who witnessed and survived the events. Told across 14 posters, this exhibition includes archival photographs and images of artifacts from the Museum's permanent collection.

*The exhibit will be in the Library's Community Room for the month of September.*
