This educational exhibition recounts the events of September 11, 2001, through the personal stories of those who witnessed and survived the events. Told across 14 posters, this exhibition includes archival photographs and images of artifacts from the Museum's permanent collection.



Storytime is an excellent opportunity for caregivers to introduce children to the library and books. We encourage one adult for every two children. Siblings are always welcome!


Storytime includes stories, songs, fingerplays, and fun at the Sloatsburg Library. Registration is required. Ages BIRTH TO 5 YRS


