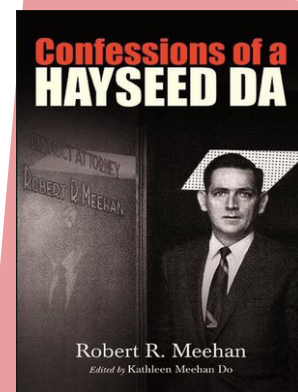


CONFESSIONS OF A HAYSEED DA
