## In Memoriam: Clair Burgeson Library Trustee 1974-1977



Clair Burgeson passed away on March 30th, 2015 in Boca Raton, Florida. He is survived by his wife, Joyce, his three children: Stephen, David and Lisa and his six grandchildren.

Clair had a love of learning, nature, spirituality and philosophy. Due to his love of learning, Clair earned many diplomas and degrees including a Master's Degree in Library Sciences from Columbia University. In 1967, Clair took the

position of Director of Librarians in the Ramapo Central School District.

From 1974-1977 Clair served as a Sloatsburg Library Trustee and had a big part in helping the Library move into its current location. He will be greatly missed.
